Re: Numbers and Number Plates

Effective immediately, the minimum size requirement for the front number plate digits has been changed from seven (7) to six (6) inches. All motorcycles entered in either the AMA Supercross or AMA Supercross Lites classes must meet this criteria, in addition to all other standards for numbers and number plates as set forth in the 2010 Monster Energy AMA Supercross and FIM World Championship rulebook.

Please review the numbers and number plate section for both classes found in the 2010 Monster Energy AMA Supercross, and FIM World Championship rulebook. To ensure that no time is wasted in technical inspection, please make sure that your motorcycle complies with these standards beforehand.

The following is an excerpt from the 2010 rulebook for reference. Please see the 2010 rulebook for the complete standards for numbers and number plates.

- Numbers must be a solid color.
- Excessive condensing or stretching of the numbers is not permitted.
- **Front numbers must be a minimum height of seven 6 inches.**
- **Side numbers must be a minimum height of 5½ inches.**
- The current Class Champion using the number 1 is allowed to use a special-sized number.
- Number **display area** must be of adequate area to provide ample space (approximately 1 inch) around and between numbers.
- Front number plates must be mounted in such a manner as to prevent deflection of the plate during the event. Any attempt at streamlining, such as curved plates, or plates that are not rigidly mounted, is prohibited, unless such plates are standard on the homologated model.
- Plastic or fiberglass number plates have a minimum thickness of 1/16 inch.
- Only numbers and the approved AMA logo, FIM logo or series sponsorship logos are permitted on the number plate **display area**.
