



License & Entry Requirements for International Participants

Option 1 (Rider Release): *Preferred*

- **450SX Class:**
 - The international participant submits to the AMA a rider release from their FMN (Home Federation).
 - The participant must hold a current FIM Motocross World Championship License or approval letter from their FMN acknowledging that the rider is eligible for a FIM Motocross World Championship License to be issued by the AMA.
 - The participant is responsible for all fees including AMA membership, entry fees and the submission of all required forms.
- **250SX Class:**
 - The international participant submits to the AMA a rider release from their FMN (Home Federation).
 - The participant must hold a current FIM Motocross World Championship License.
 - The participant is responsible for all fees including AMA membership, entry fees and the submission of all required forms.

Option 2 (Start Permission):

- **450SX & 250SX Classes:**
 - The international participant submits to the AMA a start permission from their FMN (Home Federation).
 - The start permission can be for the entire AMA Supercross Series or individual events.
 - The participant must hold a current FIM Motocross World Championship License and provide a copy to the AMA.
 - The participant will be issued a series credential and AMA membership at no charge.
 - The participant is responsible for all entry fees and the submission of all required forms.
