



License & Entry Requirements for International Participants

Start Permission: *Preferred

- **450SX & 250SX Classes:**
 - The international participant submits to the AMA a start permission from their FMN (Home Federation).
 - The participant must hold a current FIM International Motocross License and provide a copy to the AMA.
 - The participant must submit the Confirmation of International Rider Eligibility form signed by their FMN (Home Federation).
 - The start permission can be for the entire AMA Supercross Series or individual events.
 - The participant is responsible for all credentialing and entry fees along with the submission of all required forms.

Rider Release:

- Please contact Connie Fleming directly for specific rider release instructions.

Please Note:

All AMA Supercross licenses are considered provisional. The license process will not be considered complete until the rider competes in their first **three** events without issue.

AMA Supercross eligibility is issued at the discretion of the AMA and may be revoked at any time.
